SELECTION CRITERIA FOR ENTEROSTOMAL THERAPIST RECOGNITION AWARD NOMINEE

The selection criteria will be considered by the four most recent E.T. Recognition Award recipients. The following are the criteria that must be adhered to:

- 1. Experience with accountability and responsibility**
E.T. nurse functions as an educator, clinician, consultant, researcher, and an administrator. A skilled and well-experienced E.T. nurse contributes and provides services, support and guidance as needed to ostomates in the community.
- 2. Membership of a Chapter/Ostomy Canada Society**
As a member of good standing the E.T. nurse must be accessible and participate in the functions and activities of the chapter and Ostomy Canada Society.
- 3. Good Attendance at Chapter meetings**
Regular attendance as a member of a chapter creates more opportunities to get involved and contribute to the chapter and Ostomy Canada Society.
- 4. Encourages Chapter Membership**
E.T. nurse encourages his/her ostomy patients to attend chapter meetings for continuing support and help.
- 5. Involvement in Chapter Outreach Support Services (COSS)**
E.T. nurse calls on the services of a chapter's trained visitors to meet with new ostomy patients and supports the COSS program by participating in seminars to train ostomy visitors.
- 6. Good Leader/Involvement in Educational Programs**
Good leadership results in productivity. It can bring positive and good influences in helping new ostomates and chapter members. One aspect of good leadership is involvement in educational programs at the local, regional and national levels.
- 7. Excellent Fundraiser**
It is important for the E.T. nurse to get involved in fundraising initiatives. Increased funding makes it possible for a chapter/Ostomy Canada Society to engage in development of programs and services.
- 8. Involvement with a Chapter/Ostomy Canada Society**
Ostomy Canada Society provides numerous programs and services which are beneficial to its members. An E.T. nurse who participates in any of these programs/services is in a great position to share his/her expertise, to promote better communication and to mentor its members.
- 9. Good Personality**
A pleasant personality helps an E.T. nurse to develop meaningful relationships. A good communicator and listener, with a caring and compassionate attitude, helps new ostomates and members increase their self-esteem and improve their 'quality of life'. With these overall characteristics an E.T. nurse encourages chapter members to support each other.
