

Ostomy Canada Society's Post-Secondary Award

The \$1,000 Ostomy Canada Post-Secondary award shall be awarded annually to encourage and assist individuals living with a permanent ostomy or other bowel or bladder diversionary surgery, to pursue Post-Secondary Education.

AWARD OBJECTIVES

- To motivate post secondary students to be informed about Ostomy Canada Society services and its support of people in Canada living with an ostomy.
- To provide financial support to a postgraduate student
- To encourage volunteerism and leadership that “gives back” to the ostomy community.

ADMINISTRATION OF THE AWARD

Ostomy Canada Society will administer this award once per year in the amount of \$1,000. Award funds will be mailed, by cheque, to the recipient. Incomplete applications will not be reviewed. This award may only be awarded once to the same recipient. Only award winners will be contacted. All applications must be received by March 31.

QUALIFICATIONS & HOW TO APPLY

Applicants have up to two (2) years from the date of completion of their Canadian education program such as one year of university or apprentice or trade program to apply. Proof of date of completion must be provided.

The Applicant must:

- Be a Canadian citizen and Canadian resident.
- Be a supporter of Ostomy Canada Society (verified by the Ostomy Canada Society National Office).
- Be living with a permanent ostomy or other bladder or bowel diversionary surgery
- Provide their social insurance number
- Give permission and provide a photo and background story to be published in Ostomy Canada magazine
- Submit an essay (up to 2000 words, may include pictures) describing their thoughts on and approach to volunteerism including a description of their extracurricular, unpaid work with people living with an ostomy on a local or nation level. *All essays become the property of Ostomy Canada Society and may be published in any Society materials.*
